At Ignatius Farm, we rent affordable, organically-managed plots to people just like you.

Regardless of why you are interested in a garden plot, regardless of whether you are a master gardener or have never gardened in your life, regardless of how big (or how small) of a plot suits your needs, or if for you the best part of community gardening is the people you meet, Ignatius Farm's "community rented gardens" is the answer.

How it works

Each fall and spring, Ignatius Farm staff work to make your garden the best it can be. Staff prepare the soil, ploughing and disking-in green manure crops and amendments. Staff mark out the various plots prior to planning in May, according to the number of the season's gardeners and the size of their plots. Hand water stations are set up throughout the plots. **The rest is up to you!**
